With 1 week to go, we are full steam ahead with our preparations for this year's summer fair!

- **Raffle Tickets** – Your raffle tickets should be attached to this newsletter. There are some great prizes to be won this year including days out at Goodwood as well as a cash prize! It would be great if everyone could sell all their books, but if there are any leftover please return them to the school as we will sell them on the day at the Fair.
- **Cake Competition** – As always we will be running our ever successful cake stall so we would appreciate any and all cupcake donations (homemade or shop bought) which will need to be brought in on the day of the fair (Year 1 can bring theirs in on the Thursday morning as they are going to the Arena on the Friday). There will also be a competition for the best cupcakes from each year group with a small prize being given to the chosen winners. Please make sure you label any Tupperware or tins you would like returned, these will be available to collect from the office after the Fair.
- **Jam Jar Hoopla** – This year we will be running our jam jar hoopla stall again, so we will be asking you to fill one or more jars with the usual sweets/small toys.
