Sun Safe Information

Now that the summer will shortly be upon us, we wanted to remind you about our sun safe policy. We have developed this

to ensure that we can all enjoy the sun safely over the coming months. The sun's rays are particularly strong over the summer and they can damage children's skin. This may not seem like a problem right now, but it can lead to skin cancer in later life. Your child's health and well-being are very important to us, which is why we: -

- Spend time learning about sun protection.
- Provide shade in the playground.
- Encourage pupils to wear fully brimmed sun hats (not baseball caps) when outside.
- Encourage pupils to use at least SPF 25 sunscreen in summer months

You can help by: -

- Talking to your child about the importance of sun protection at home.
- Sending your child to school with a widebrimmed sun hat (not a baseball cap, which offers little protection to the back of the neck).
- Putting sunscreen on your child before they come to school each day during the summer months
