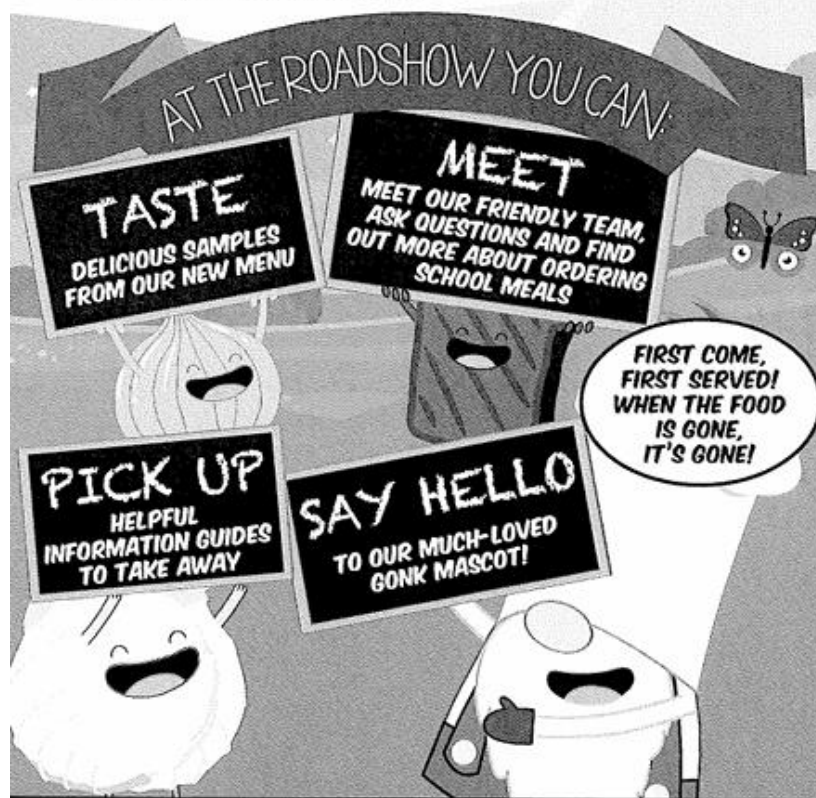
We're excited to be visiting schools and communities across West Sussex from 1 June to 17 July as we prepare to launch our new school food service this September.
