It has been a busy end of term with fantastic nativities and singing performances. This can bring challenges for some children with changes to their routine and differences in their environments with Christmas decorations. We know it can also be hard during the holidays too with these changes.

Here are some ideas to help during the festive time:

Visual timetables: Create visual timetables that outline the day. Be clear with your child on what they can expect from each part of the day, going over any aspects they may find especially tricky, such as visiting relatives or crowds. You can draw pictures or role play to help them understand.

Sensory Considerations: Prepare sensory-friendly activities and environments, ensuring that your child has a safe space away from the festive chaos when needed.

Try to describe what your children's needs are ahead of any family visits so that you can explain fully and agree adjustments that work for everyone.

Consider planning one or more recovery days after the main Christmas events to allow your child to decompress and unwind by doing whatever helps them cope with potentially overwhelming situations.



Individual Learning Plans (ILPs)

If your child has an individual learning plan with targets to help them, teachers have reviewed and written new plans. You will receive a copy before the Christmas break. Some children may need to have interventions outside of the classroom which take place in Sky Hub (where the Inclusion team are based), whereas some children's needs will be met with tailored provision in the classroom.

If your child has a speech and language plan, these will be reviewed continually throughout the year.

If you are not sure whether your child has an ILP, then please check with your class teacher.
