Coming up...

SEND Parent drop in – Tuesday 11th November 2:30-3pm

We are going to be holding an informal drop in where you can come and meet the Inclusion team to find out more about what we do to support your children. Please come to the school office, and we will walk you to the school hall where we can talk to you about our roles.

The meeting will finish in time for you to collect your child at the end of the day.



How is your child supported with SEND needs?

High quality classroom teaching and adaptation of lessons and resources for individual pupils are the first steps in responding to children who may have special needs.

At times, additional support is sought from external agencies, and they will offer advice and strategies for the teacher to implement. This will be captured on an Individual Learning Plan (ILP), which details the targets your child is working on and the provision that will be given to help them achieve these targets. Some children may need to have interventions outside of the classroom which mainly take place in the Sky Hub (where the Inclusion team are based), whereas some children's needs will be met with tailored provision in the classroom.

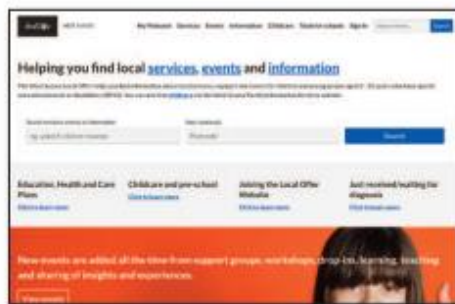
