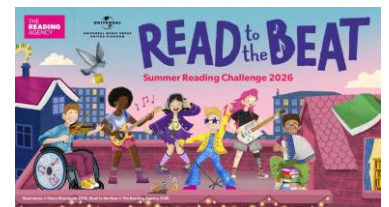


Maths Week (6th - 10th July)

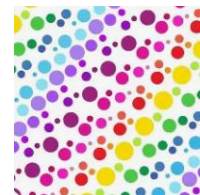
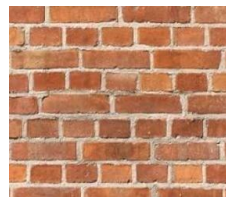
We have planned some lovely maths activities for Maths Week and, as well as their maths lessons, the children will play maths games, take part in a maths trail around the school grounds, listen to maths stories and complete a maths investigation linked to the book ‘How big is a million?’.



Pattern All Around Us - How can you get involved?

We would love for you to get involved at home by going on a pattern hunt with your child. These could be patterns of shapes/pictures or patterns in nature. I have included a few examples below. How many different patterns can your child find? Where did they find it? How can they describe it? What do they notice?

Send in a photo of their favourite discovery or send a quick email to tell me about it. The children who get involved at home will receive a ‘Pattern All Around Me 2026’ certificate for taking part.



We will also have a non-uniform day on the last day of Maths Week (Friday 10th July) where we would like your child to come to school wearing something linked with maths in some way. For example it could be a T-Shirt with a number on the back, trousers or a dress with shapes or patterns on or just bright colours. It’s up to you.

How else can you support your child at home with mathematics?

Don’t forget every child in the school has access to Numbots which will help them with counting, subitising as well as addition and subtraction. If you can’t remember your child’s log in then please do email me and I can send it to you.
