### Some ideas for home learning.

- Count pennies, toys, pencils etc. Double and halve them.
- Write a sentence once a day about what you have done. 'I played with my toys. I ran in the garden.'
- Use the sound card and sound out words.
- Write numbers correctly
- Write letters correctly
- Write key words
- Dictate a sentence for children to write using 45 keywords
- Draw and label a picture of your family
- Paint a picture of a plant in your garden
- Listen to or read a story and make your own book about it
- Listen to poems, find the rhyming words
- Write words that rhyme with pin, pot, tap dog etc
- Read and write cvc words
- Write and draw doubles of numbers  $2+2$   $4+4$
- Ask children simple addition and subtraction problems, encourage them to write the number sentence.
- Write name with correct letter formation
- Recite months of year and days of week. Talk about seasons
- Write a list of animals, birds, minibeasts and draw them
- If nothing else, read, read, read to your children, encourage them to retell stories, predict what might happen next and talk about the settings, characters etc. Also read non-fiction books, information online about things they like and poems.
