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#### **NEWSLETTER – June 2022**

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you all had an enjoyable half term week and extended Jubilee Bank Holiday weekend. There are now only seven weeks until the end of the school year, with lots going on, so please keep an eye out for letters and ParentMails which will keep you up to date on what is happening.

A few people have asked me recently what is happening with our wooden play equipment. Unfortunately, it has been out of use for quite a while now. Alongside the daily inspections we undertake, we have to have an annual inspection by a qualified inspector. In our 2020/21 inspection, a number of items were found to have early rotting and we were advised to get repairs in order to keep the equipment in use. We requested these repairs with the company who maintained the equipment but due to the pandemic and related issues getting materials, they were not able to make repairs until 9 months later. Just as this was about to happen, the 2021/22 annual inspection took place and the condition of the equipment had deteriorated so much that we were instructed to immediately take it out of use as it was unsafe.

Unfortunately, play equipment, either to repair or replace, is not cheap! Since the inspection in January, we have been busy working to get the money together and we were able to do that by the end of March. We then obtained quotes from a range of companies and placed an order to replace / repair all items in April. The issue still remains with obtaining materials and so the work cannot take place until the selected company is able to get all required materials.

We realise that some of you are frustrated that your children don't have access to the equipment at playtimes but this is out of our control. We do get out other items such as balls, hoops, skipping ropes, etc. so they have something to do. We are keeping our fingers crossed that we will be able to get the project completed soon.


