




Maths Week 3rd - 7th February 2020

'Festival of Shape'

We are holding an exciting maths week where we are focusing on 2D and 3D shape across the school. All of the children will be learning about the properties of shape and looking for 2D and 3D shapes in our school environment. We will also be learning shape songs and playing maths games where we will be focusing on solving problems together.

Competition Time

As part of our 'Festival of Shape' your child can take part in our competition. Your child can draw or build an animal using 2D or 3D shapes. They can bring in their picture or a photograph of their model before Wednesday 5th February so that we can display them all in school and find out who the winners will be. There will be one winner per class. While your child is using the shapes to create their animal, talk to them about the shapes they are using. Can they name the shape, tell you the number of sides, the number of faces or the number of edges?
