Your child's Flu vaccination is now due!

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on **1st October 2026** to offer your child the **nasal Flu spray vaccination**.

Please complete a consent form for your child to say YES or NO for them to have this vaccine.

This must be completed by a Parent or Legal Guardian with Parental Responsibility

Follow the steps below, **before the school link closing date and time**, which is at 11am, 2 working days before the school session date above. If you miss the cut off time, the consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination within one of our catch-up clinics.
