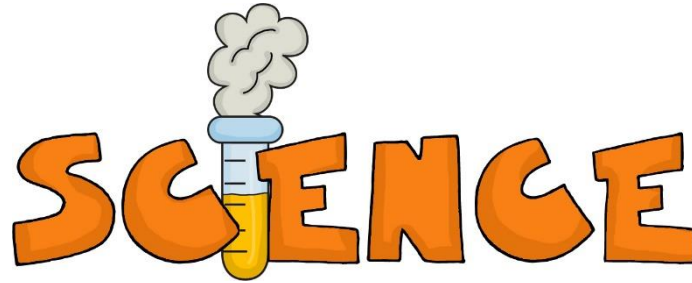


Rose Green Infant School Science Week
