Colour (paint, ink, dye, textiles, pencils, crayon, pastels)	<ul> <li>Recognise and name the primary and secondary colours</li> <li>Explore mixing colours</li> <li>Use paintbrushes and other tools to add colour to their work</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Mix the primary colours to create secondary colours</li> <li>Use a range of tools to add colour including different size paint brushes</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Mix a wider variety of colours</li> <li>Change the shade and tint of pure colours</li> <li>Use different techniques to add colour including layering, scraping, and blending</li> <li>Use a range of tools and media to add colour including different size paint brushes</li> </ul>

Printing (found materials, fruit/veg, wood blocks, press print, lino, string)	<ul> <li>Explore using a range of printing tools to make marks</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Make marks in print with a variety of objects, including natural and made objects.</li> <li>Carry out different printing techniques e.g. block, relief and resist printing.</li> <li>Make rubbings.</li> <li>Build a repeating pattern and recognise pattern in the environment.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use a variety of techniques, including carbon printing, relief, press and fabric printing and rubbings.</li> <li>Design patterns of increasing complexity and repetition.</li> <li>Print using a variety of material, objects and techniques.</li> </ul>

Form (3D work, clay, dough, boxes, wire, paper sculpture, mod roc)	<ul> <li>Make simple models using junk modelling</li> <li>Use a range of bending/ soft materials to make simple shapes and models.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Manipulate clay in a variety of ways, e.g., rolling, kneading and shaping.</li> <li>Explore sculpture with a range of malleable media, especially clay.</li> <li>Experiment with, construct and join recycled, natural and man-made materials.</li> <li>Explore shape and form.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Manipulate clay for a variety of purposes, including thumb pots, simple coil pots and models.</li> <li>Understand the safety and basic care of materials and tools.</li> <li>Experiment with, construct and join recycled, natural and man-made materials more confidently.</li> </ul>

Textiles/Collage (paper, fabric, natural materials, sewing)	<ul> <li>Explore the texture of a variety of materials</li> <li>Complete simple weaving</li> <li>Complete Simple collages</li> <li>Use scissor to cut materials making them smaller in size</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Select, describe and use appropriate materials to create different textures</li> <li>Investigate textures through making rubbings.</li> <li>Cut and tear paper, card and other materials for collages</li> <li>Gather and sort the materials they will need</li> <li>Make simple paper weaves.</li> <li>Use running stitches</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Use different kinds of materials on their collage and explain why they have chosen them</li> <li>Explore the effects of cutting, tearing and layering paper to create different effects</li> <li>Start to explore other simple stitches</li> <li>Use repeated patterns in their collage</li> <li>Explore ways to colour fabrics with natural dyes, e.g. tea, onion, etc.</li> </ul>
